ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- 1. Prepares and cooks food and manages a school food service program.
- 2. Plans menus to meet pupil nutritive requirements.
- 3. Requisitions foods and supplies.
- 4. Prepares and serves food.
- 5. Manages the storage and care of foods and supplies.
- 6. Cleans the kitchen, serving, and storage areas and the care of equipment.
- 7. Maintains simple records of food and supplies received and used.
- 8. Prepares and submits reports on activities of the cafeteria.
- 9. Preforms related work as required.
