
WHAT IS THE SAINT JOHN'S BIBLE?

The Saint John's Bible is the first handwritten Bible to be commissioned by a Benedictine monastery in over 500 years. Saint John's University commissioned renowned calligrapher Donald Jackson to produce this work of sacred art in 1998. The project was completed in 2011. This singular achievement features the complete text of the Bible (in the NRSV English translation), written on calfskin vellum using traditional tools and inks.

The Saint John's Bible unites an ancient Benedictine monastic tradition of manuscript writing with the technology and vision of today: illuminating the Word of God for a new millennium.

We invite you into a peaceful space to ignite your spiritual imagination. As you gaze upon these illuminations, spiritual meditations on a text, consider these questions:


Reflect: Set your gaze upon the *Creation*Frontispiece. As the days of your life progress, how do you notice God's activity in the ongoing act of creation?



Just for fun: Find the remnants of the Ten Commandments.





CALL OUT TO GOD BOLDLY AND WITHOUT FEAR.



Beginning on the left and running horizontally across to the right are a series of thin, golden, graph-like lines. These threads are an oscillograph of the monks' voices at Saint John's Abbey chanting their daily prayer; the lines run through every page until the end of the volume.

A careful look will also show vertical lines of the same type intersecting with the horizontal ones. These verticals are also oscillographs of singing but of the Jewish Shema, the Muslim call to prayer, a Buddhist, Taoist, and Hindu chant, as well as a Greek Anthem and a Native American song. God is Lord of creation, and all creation reflects this truth and goodness. The church always rejoices in truth wherever it may be found.



This volume was completed in 2002; look for the depiction of the World Trade Twin Towers.


Why do you think Donald Jackson chose to include this in the illumination?

HOW ARE YOU TRANSFORMED?




Sit with an illumination from Paul's Letters or Revelation.
