A MESSAGE FROM OUR PASTOR

DEAR BROTHERS AND SISTERS IN CHRIST,

LENT BEGINS: ASH WEDNESDAY – February 22, 2023



The Season of Lent will begin with the celebration of Ash Wednesday on February 22.

Please note that this year ashes will be imposed on a person's forehead in the usual manner with ashes imposed in the sign of a cross. The priests and deacons will be assisted by our Eucharistic Ministers and the distribution of ashes will take place following the homily. We will use the four communion stations. Ashes will also be available on Ash Wednesday in small packets for those who wish to bring them home to sick family members and/or shut-ins.

The Mass Schedule for Ash Wednesday will be as follows:

- 7:30 a.m. Mass
- 9:00 a.m. Mass
- 12:10 p.m. Mass
- 3:00 p.m. (no Mass) - Liturgy of the Word & Distribution of Ashes
- 7:30 p.m. Mass

THE SEASON OF LENT

Lent is ordered to preparing for the celebration of Easter, since the Lenten liturgy prepares for celebration of the Paschal Mystery both catechumens (unbaptized), by the various stages of Christian Initiation, and the faithful, who recall their own Baptism and do penance.

The forty days of Lent run from Ash Wednesday up to but excluding the Mass of the Lord's Supper exclusive. From the beginning of Lent until the Easter Vigil, the *Alleluia* is not said.

Abstinence: All Catholics who have reached their 14th birthday are bound to abstain totally from meat on the following days: Ash Wednesday, all Fridays of Lent and Good Friday.

Fasting: All Catholics between their 18th and 59th birthdays are also bound

to observe the Law of Fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. This practice involves limiting oneself to a single full meal and avoiding food between meals. Light sustenance may be taken on two other occasions in the course of the day.

Stations of the Cross & Friday Evening Masses during Lent:

Every Friday during Lent, we will have Stations of the Cross at 7:00 p.m. followed by Mass at 7:30 p.m.

ROAD TO RENEWAL UPDATE: STATIONS OF THE CROSS

I recently met with the pastors, deacon administrators and their wives, and the lay representatives from the 6 parishes that will form our "Family of Parishes" as part of the "Road to Renewal" of our diocese. It was our second "meet and greet" to further discussions of the things we hope for as we look to forming a "Family" in the Fall of 2023. One of the suggestions was that we do as we did last year during Lent and visit each other's churches to become more familiar with each other.

During Lent, each parish will have Stations of the Cross every Friday as is our tradition, but on the following Fridays, if you wish, you are encouraged to go and pray the stations at the "host" church. Here is the schedule:

Please note that we will have Stations of the Cross every Friday during Lent here at OLV at 7:00 p.m. followed by Mass at 7:30 p.m. However, if you wish to visit our neighboring churches, you are encouraged to attend Stations of the Cross at the host parish as designated above.

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE THAT, On February 28, 2020, The Diocese of Buffalo, N.Y. ("Diocese") filed for protection under chapter 11 of title 11 of the United States Code (the "Bankruptcy Code"). The Court entered an Order (the "Supplemental Bar Date Order") setting April 17, 2023, at 11:59 P.M. (prevailing Eastern time) (the "Supplemental Bar Date") as the deadline to assert claims against the Diocese arising from or relating to abuse that occurred when the survivor was 18 years of age or older, and which, prior to the enactment of the Adult Survivors Act (S.66A/A.648A) would have been subject to a statute of limitations defense ("Adult Claims"). If you have an Adult Claim against the Diocese you must file a claim on or before the Supplemental Bar Date. ANY CLAIM FILED PURSUANT TO THE SUPPLEMENTAL BAR DATE ORDER SHALL BE WITHOUT PREJUDICE TO THE RIGHT OF ANY PARTY IN INTEREST TO ASSERT OBJECTIONS TO ANY CLAIM OR ITS TIMELINESS. 


