

Deacon Steve has a passionate commitment to promoting Catholic Charities in our diocese in order to provide for all those in need.

As we know, Father Baker spread a tremendous amount of charity over his 60 years as a priest. He sheltered the homeless, fed the hungry, cared for the sick and gave hope to people of all ages. Today, his legacy lives on here in his "City of Charity" through OLV Charities, OLV Human Services and OLV National Shrine & Basilica, which provide many similar services to those he began decades ago.

BASILICA RESTORATION UPDATE

As you can see, this past week restoration work has begun on the main floor of the Basilica. They continue to repair areas of the floor that have been broken over the years and are preparing for the new flooring under the pews. The marble floors will continue to be repaired and eventually polished throughout the Basilica.

To allow the work to continue with as little disruption as possible, both daily

Masses at 7:30 a.m. and 12:10 p.m. (Monday – Saturday morning) will now take place in the "Susan Brvenik Community Room" (former Choir Room), located on the lower level of the Basilica. 7:00 a.m. Daily Morning Prayer will also take place in the Lower Basilica.

Weekend Masses will still be accommodated in the Basilica as usual, but with modified seating and location of the temporary altar. Daily visitors are still welcome, but may be restricted to certain areas of the Basilica. Please be aware that there will be noise and disruption. This is truly an exciting new stage in our Basilica restoration efforts. All of this being done as part of our five year Centennial Celebration of the Building of the Basilica, begun by our beloved founder, Father Baker, in August of 1921 and completed for the Dedication/Consecration of the Basilica in May of 1926. We should all continue to be prepared for a fair amount of disruption in the Basilica. I am most grateful for your patience, flexibility and understanding, but our goal is to keep the Basilica open throughout the construction period and hopefully to have 50% of the work completed in time for Holy Week & Easter. Father Baker & Our Lady of Victory, pray for us!

ST. PATRICK'S DAY: Friday, March 17

Please note that the 12:10 p.m. Mass will be celebrated in the Upper Basilica to accommodate the number of people who attend the Annual St. Patrick's Day Mass and the Parade afterwards to Lackawanna City Hall.

Bishop Michael Fisher has also granted a commutation of the discipline of abstaining from meat on March 17, 2023. A commutation of this discipline means that those Catholics who choose to eat meat on Friday, March 17 are obliged to choose another day before March 24, 2023 to abstain from eating meat.

Be assured of my grateful prayers! May Father Baker intercede for you and Our Lady of Victory protect you. May God bless you all!

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE THAT, On February 28, 2020, The Diocese of Buffalo, N.Y. ("Diocese") filed for protection under chapter 11 of title 11 of the United States Code (the "Bankruptcy Code"). The Court entered an Order (the "Supplemental Bar Date Order") setting April 17, 2023, at 11:59 P.M. (prevailing Eastern time) (the "Supplemental Bar Date") as the deadline to assert claims against the Diocese arising from or relating to abuse that occurred when the survivor was 18 years of age or older, and which, prior to the enactment of the Adult Survivors Act (S.66A/A.648A) would have been subject to a statute of limitations defense ("Adult Claims"). If you have an Adult Claim against the Diocese you must file a claim on or before the Supplemental Bar Date. 


