- those who were baptized Catholic as infants but never received religious education, Confirmation, or First Eucharist

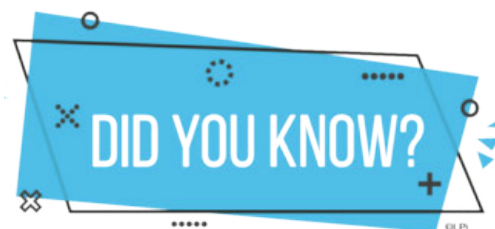
