

The Our Lady of Victory parish includes an elementary school for PreK through 8th Grade and an active Faith Formation program, along with a variety of parish-based organizations and activities.



DEAR BROTHERS AND
SISTERS IN CHRIST,

WORLD DAY OF PRAYER FOR VOCATIONS: Sunday, April 21, 2024

World Day of Prayer for Vocations will be observed this weekend, also known as “Good Shepherd Sunday.” The purpose of this day is to publicly fulfill the Lord’s instruction to “Pray the Lord of the harvest to send laborers into His harvest.” (Mt. 9:38; Luke 10:2). We need vocations, especially vocations to the Priesthood, more than ever today.
