A MESSAGE FROM OUR PASTOR

DEAR BROTHERS AND SISTERS IN CHRIST,

SOLEMNITY OF THE ASSUMPTION OF THE BLESSED VIRGIN MARY: AUGUST 15, 2024

The Solemnity of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary, celebrated annually on August 15th, marks a profound moment in Christian tradition and theology. This feast commemorates the belief that Mary, the mother of Jesus, was assumed body and soul into heaven at the end of her earthly life. It is a celebration of Mary's unique role in salvation history and her exemplary faith and devotion.

The Assumption is a testament to the dignity and sanctity of Mary, who, through her unwavering faith and obedience to God's will, became the mother of our Savior. This solemnity underscores the hope of eternal life and the promise of resurrection for all who follow Christ. It reminds the faithful of the ultimate destiny that awaits those who live in accordance with God's will.

The belief in Mary's Assumption has ancient roots in the Christian tradition, with early references dating back to the 4th and 5th centuries. However, it was not until November 1, 1950 that Pope Pius XII formally defined the dogma of the Assumption in the apostolic constitution *Munificentissimus Deus*. This declaration affirmed that Mary was "assumed body and soul into heavenly glory."

Here at Our Lady of Victory Basilica, the Great Dome mural depicts the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary into Heaven, along with her coronation as Queen of Heaven by the Holy Trinity. The Blessed Mother is carried to Heaven by the Archangels Michael, Gabriel and Raphael, while several saints and apostles welcome her into Heaven surrounded by angels.

It is anticipated that the work will continue through 2026. The original plan was to have it done in time for the 100th Anniversary of the Consecration of the Basilica in May of 2026.

On August 15th, we will have a public announcement on how the people of WNY and beyond can help "Save the Dome & Adopt An Angel!" More information will be forthcoming.

I continue to be deeply grateful to our Restoration Committee under the leadership of Hank Balling, III of Guard Construction and Contracting Corp., and Jake Schneider of Schneider Architectural Services, PC.




the tree and drop the requested item off at the school prior to August 30. Our teachers and students will be most appreciative!




