A MESSAGE FROM OUR PASTOR

DEAR BROTHERS AND SISTERS IN CHRIST,

LENT BEGINS: ASH WEDNESDAY – February 14, 2024

The Season of Lent will begin with the celebration of Ash Wednesday on February 14. The priests and deacon will be assisted by our Eucharistic Ministers and the distribution of ashes will take place following the homily. We will use the four Communion stations as we do for the distribution of Holy Communion. Ashes will also be available on Ash Wednesday in small packets for those who wish to bring them home to sick family members and/or shut-ins.

The Mass Schedule for Ash Wednesday will be as follows:

- 7:30 a.m. Mass
- 9:00 a.m. Mass
- 12:10 p.m. Mass
- **3:00 p.m. (no Mass)** Liturgy of the Word & Distribution of Ashes
- 7:30 p.m. Mass

THE SEASON OF LENT

Lent is ordered to preparing for the celebration of Easter, since the Lenten liturgy prepares for celebration of the Paschal Mystery both catechumens (unbaptized), by the various stages of Christian Initiation, and the faithful, who recall their own Baptism and do penance. The forty days of Lent run from Ash Wednesday up to but excluding the Mass of the Lord's Supper exclusive. From the beginning of Lent until the Easter Vigil, the *Alleluia* is not said.

Abstinence: All Catholics who have reached their 14th birthday are bound to abstain totally from meat on the following days: Ash Wednesday, all Fridays of Lent and Good Friday.


Fasting: All Catholics between their 18th and 59th birthdays are also bound to observe the Law of Fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. This practice involves limiting oneself to a single full meal and avoiding food between meals. Light sustenance may be taken on two other occasions in the course of the day.

Stations of the Cross & Friday Evening Masses during Lent:

Every Friday during Lent we will have Stations of the Cross at 7:00 p.m. followed by Mass at 7:30 p.m.

CATHOLIC CHARITIES APPEAL 2024

The Season of Lent always coincides with our Annual Catholic Charities Appeal and Fund for the Faith.
