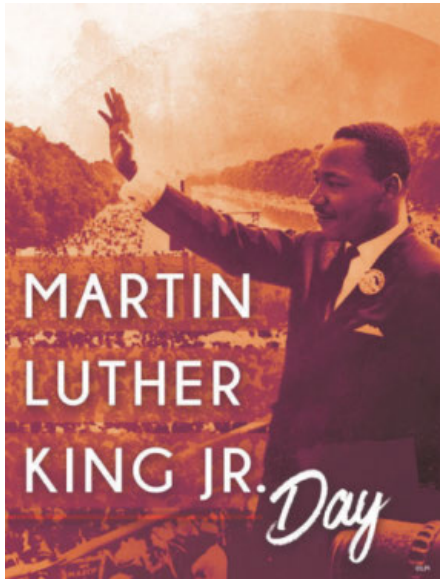

**RESTORATION OF  
SANCTUARY FLOOR:  
Beginning Monday, January 22**

As you know, over the past two years we have done a considerable amount of restoration work on the outside of the Basilica, including the drainage system, roof replacement and repairs, as well as ongoing work with the stained glasses windows throughout the Basilica.

This past year we completed the restoration of the pews and most of the floors. The last area that needs to be restored is the main sanctuary floor. **Beginning Monday, January 22, the weekday Masses at 7:30 a.m. and 12:10 p.m. will be celebrated in the Lower Basilica in the Brvenik Community Room.** It is estimated the work will be completed in two to three weeks. Weekend Masses will continue to be held in the Upper Basilica. During the restoration of the sanctuary floor, there is a possibility that Funerals requested on weekdays may be moved to another nearby church in order to allow the sanctuary project to be completed within the estimated time frame.

Once again, I deeply appreciate your patience and understanding as we continue to do the necessary restoration work to preserve our beautiful Basilica for the next 100 years!

I am also profoundly grateful to all those who have donated towards our Centennial Capital Campaign to allow us to continue the legacy of Father Baker and to care for our magnificent basilica. **PILGRIMAGE: FOLLOW IN THE  
FOOTSTEPS OF FATHER BAKER**

**There is still room if you wish to join us on this awe-inspiring pilgrimage of faith, planned for April 30—May 9, 2024.** While on this sacred excursion, we'll travel to Paris and Rome, retracing and reliving the pilgrimage that changed Father Baker's life forever 150 years ago.

In May of 1874, Father Baker embarked on the ship, S.S. Periere, setting a course for France to visit and worship at the holy sites and magnificent shrines of Europe. In Paris, he visited Notre Dame des Victoires, and it was there that his faith was transformed. Upon entering the shrine, Father Baker's eyes focused immediately on the beautiful statue of Our Lady of Victory. As he knelt at the communion rail, gazing at the statue of Our Lady, he made a promise:

*"From now on, I will devote my entire life to your service. I shall devote all my thoughts and actions to your name. I will spread devotion of Our Lady of Victory throughout America."*

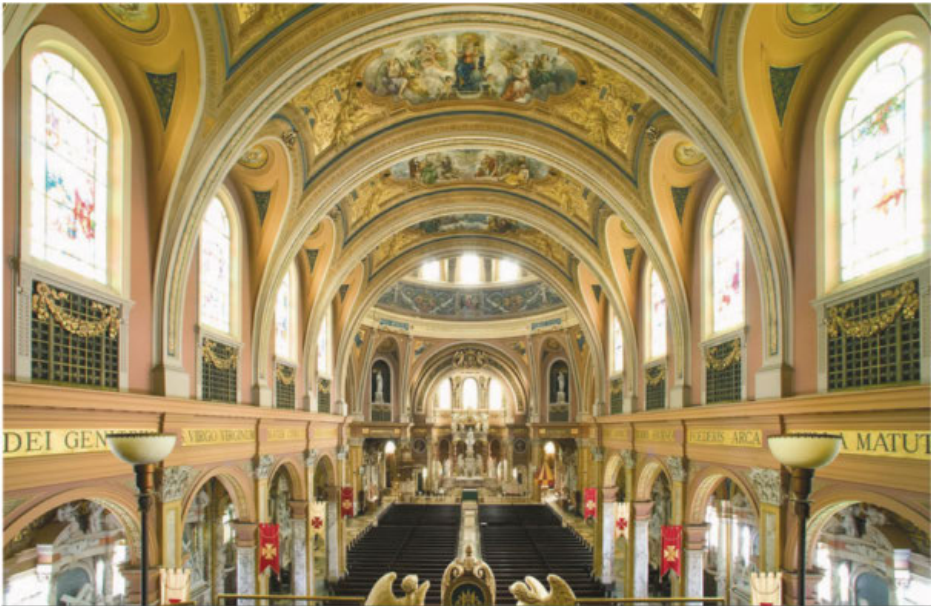
