#### PRO-LIFE STATEMENT: UNITED STATES CONFERENCE OF CATHOLIC BISHOPS (USCCB):

**REFLECT:** The Supreme Court's decision in Dobbs v. Jackson Women's Health Organization ended the nearly fifty-year nationwide reign of abortion-on-demand that was ushered in by Roe v. Wade in January of 1973. In this monumental legal victory, the Supreme Court rightly concluded that there is nothing in the Constitution's text, history, American legal tradition, or the Court's precedents that prevents the government from protecting preborn

children in the womb from the violence of abortion. Dobbs returned the issue of abortion to the people's elected representatives at the federal and state levels. And as we have seen, continuing work is needed to protect children, women, and families from the tragedy of abortion. We must continue advocating for pro-life laws and policies, especially at the state and local levels. Abortion is legal in more states than not, with many working to expand and enshrine abortion protections. In addition to our efforts to protect human life in law, we must also help women facing unexpected or difficult pregnancies, offering them the compassionate support they need to lovingly welcome the gift of their children. We must do whatever we can in every sphere to ensure the flourishing of both mothers and their children throughout life's journey.

#### RESTORATION OF SANCTUARY FLOOR: Beginning Monday, January 22

As you know, over the past two years we have done a considerable amount of restoration work on the outside of the Basilica, including the drainage system, roof replacement and repairs, as well as ongoing work with the stained glasses windows throughout the Basilica.

This past year we completed the restoration of the pews and most of the floors. The last area that needs to be restored is the main sanctuary floor. Beginning Monday, January 22, the weekday Masses at 7:30 a.m. and 12:10 p.m. will be celebrated in the Lower Basilica in the Brvenik Community Room. It is estimated the work will be completed in two to three weeks. Weekend Masses will continue to be held in the Upper Basilica.

During the restoration of the sanctuary floor, there is a possibility that Funerals requested on weekdays may be moved to another nearby church in order to allow the sanctuary project to be completed within the estimated time frame.


Once again, I deeply appreciate your patience and understanding as we continue to do the necessary restoration work to preserve our beautiful Basilica for the next 100 years!




