

DEAR BROTHERS AND SISTERS IN CHRIST,

CATHOLIC CHARITIES GUEST SPEAKER ON MARCH 16—17: KEVIN GANNON

This weekend, we welcome Kevin Gannon to OLV Basilica, who will speak at all of the weekend Masses on the Catholic Charities Appeal 2024. It is most appropriate that Kevin, a native son of our OLV Basilica Parish, will be here to speak on St. Patrick's Day. St. Patrick is the Patron Saint for the 2024 Catholic Charities Appeal and, as you know, the original church before the building of the Basilica was St. Patrick's Church on what was then known as Limestone Hill.

Father Baker was also the original signer for the Catholic Charities Charter when it began in 1923. I encourage all of our parishioners to be as generous as possible in supporting this year's appeal. Every donation large or small makes a difference in caring for those most in need in our Western New York Community.

**GREAT NEWS—
NEW ORGAN INFORMATION:**

I am pleased to announce the installation of a new organ, located in the Sanctuary of the Basilica. The work will be performed by Smith & Gilbert Pipe Organs, who service our main organ located in the rear gallery of the Basilica. Last spring we were notified of a 1967 Gress-Miles pipe organ that was available and Timothy Smith from Smith & Gilbert felt that it would serve as the perfect nucleus for a second organ in the Basilica. The pipes for the new organ will reside in an upper room above the Sacristy.

The console (where the organist sits and plays from) will be located near the Altar of St. Joseph. The console was refinished by the Kittinger Furniture Company to match the Basilica's recently restored pews.

Music in the Basilica will still mainly come from the choir loft. The new sanctuary organ will provide another option for weddings, funerals, Friday morning school Masses, and concerts. Most importantly, the new organ will provide a fallback instrument and time to assess the condition of the heavily used and relied upon gallery organ. The new sanctuary organ is expected to be completed this spring with a formal dedicatory recital to be announced. More to come!


