A MESSAGE FROM OUR PASTOR

DEAR BROTHERS AND SISTERS IN CHRIST,

ROAD TO RENEWAL: FINAL DECISIONS

On Monday, September 9, Bishop Michael Fisher and Rev. Bryan Zielenieski, Vicar for Renewal, addressed the clergy and the lay representatives from the vicariates (regions) of our diocese to share the announcement of Final Decisions for the rightsizing and reshaping of the Diocese of Buffalo. Rev. Sean DiMaria, who is the Vicar Forane of the Southern Erie Vicariate of which we are a part, shared how this affects us here in our area.

Within our Family #26 (Our Lady of the Sacred Heart, Orchard Park, Our Mother of Good Counsel, Blasdell, Our Lady of Victory National Shrine & Basilica, Our Lady of Bistrica, Queen of Angels, & St. Anthony, Lackawanna), the Final Decisions are:

Projected number of active priests for this family by 2030 = 3 (including OLV)

- St. Anthony, Lackawanna will merge with Our Lady of the Sacred Heart, Orchard Park—entire property of St. Anthony will be sold.
- 2. Our Mother of Good Counsel, Blasdell will merge with Our Lady of the Sacred Heart, Orchard Park—entire property of OMGC will be sold.
- 3. Queen of Angels, Lackawanna will merge with Our Lady of the Sacred Heart, Orchard Park and become a secondary worship site for multi-cultural ministry.
- 4. Our Lady of Bistrica will merge with Our Lady of Victory, with the opportunity for the Croatian Mass and priest to work with OLV and continue their ministry. This would need to be discerned with the leadership of OLV as to how this will take place.

<u>Parishes open in family:</u> Our Lady of the Sacred Heart, Orchard Park Our Lady of Victory Basilica, Lackawanna

<u>Secondary worship sites:</u> Queen of Angels, Lackawanna

<u>Parish merging/closed:</u> St. Anthony, Lackawanna Our Mother of Good Counsel, Blasdell Our Lady of Bistrica, Lackawanna

Further details on the timeline and implementation for the changes, and last Masses at the locations will be shared with you soon as they are known.

I know this is not easy for anyone, but especially for the parishioners of parishes that are closing and merging. My heart and my prayers go out to all of the people in our area as well as throughout our entire diocese. I specifically want to reach out to Fr. Christopher Coric, OFM Conv. and the lay faithful of Our Lady of Bistrica Parish. On behalf of all of us here at Our Lady of Victory National Shrine & Basilica, we welcome with open arms, all of the individuals and families that belong to Our Lady of Bistrica. It is with profound sentiments of gratitude and esteem, that I thank Fr. Chris, for his many years of exemplary priestly ministry as Pastor of Our Lady of Bistrica and his dedication to the Croatian Community both near and far. I can assure you, I will do whatever needs to be done to ease the transition and to honor the faith and traditions of Our Lady of Bistrica Parish.

I invite everyone to pray fervently for our entire Diocesan Family, our Bishop Michael Fisher, our clergy, religious and laity as we navigate these challenging times and strive to remain strong in faith, hope and love. We are facing a shortage of priests, so we need to pray daily for an increase of vocations to the priesthood as well as for the diaconate and religious life. We also need to encourage our young people and families to attend Mass and receive the Sacraments. This is what guides our moral compass and helps us to live our lives according to the will of God. Jesus repeatedly mentions in the Gospels, "Do not be afraid, I am with you!" Let us journey now together and support one another through faith, prayer and good works.

When Father Baker built this magnificent shrine, he wanted it to be a place where all are welcome. That is our tag line here at Our Lady of Victory National Shrine & Basilica as we continue to celebrate our Centennial (2021-2026). All are truly welcome! May Our Lady of Victory watch over and protect our entire diocese and may Father Baker inspire us to never give up and to trust that God will always, always provide!

As you know, the copper on the Basilica's dome needs to be replaced at a cost that will exceed three million dollars. Buffalo's harsh climate has taken its toll on the dome over the past 100 years since it

was completed in 1925 and water infiltration has significantly damaged the plaster and interior paintings.

It is now incumbent upon us to do our very best to care for this magnificent shrine for years to come. This public phase of our Centennial Campaign is a community-wide initiative.
