DEAR BROTHERS AND SISTERS IN CHRIST,

A CALL FOR NEW LITURGICAL MINISTERS:

As we move back into post-summer/ school/business-as-usual mode, I really want to focus on growing our Liturgical Ministries and other activities for our wonderful Basilica Parish Family. As a result of the Diocesan "Road to Renewal," we are blessed to have many new individuals and families who have registered in our parish and we welcome their presence and active involvement in the life of our parish community.

We are in need of **Altar Servers** (boys and girls who have made their First Holy Communion are most welcome). This is a very important ministry and a wonderful opportunity for our children to appreciate the celebration of the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass by their service at the altar assisting the Priests & Deacons. Training will be provided.

SOUTHERN ERIE LIFE CHAIN: SUNDAY, OCTOBER 6, 2024

I invite you to join the clergy, religious and laity from the parishes of our Southern Erie Vicariate to participate in the Life Chain on Sunday, October 6 from 2:00—3:00 p.m. The Life Chain is a time to stand together for respect for

all life from the moment of conception to natural death. We stand in silent prayer, praying the rosary and witnessing to life. The Life Chain will form along Ridge Road and South Park Avenue. There will be Eucharistic Adoration in the Basilica during the Life Chain for those unable to stand outside who wish to pray in silence before the Blessed Sacrament. Then all are invited to attend Benediction at 3:00 p.m.

PARISH FEAST DAY: Monday, October 7 is the Feast of Our Lady of the Rosary (formerly titled Our Lady of Victory)

This special Mass will be held on Monday, October 7 at 12:10 p.m. Our OLV Elementary School students will be present to honor our patroness, Our Lady of Victory, and to celebrate with our parishioners, employees, benefactors, and visitors. The 8th Grade Class will lead the procession with the statue of Our Lady of Victory. All are most welcome to join us for this special concelebrated Mass and the opportunity for me to personally thank our generous donors, the dedicated employees of our OLV Institutions, and parishioners/friends of OLV who help continue the legacy of Father Baker.

The powerful intercessory prayer of the rosary continues to make a positive difference in this world. More than ever, we need to pray the rosary through the intercession of Our Lady of Victory for the salvation of souls and for peace and justice throughout our country and world. Every day, I stop and pray at the tomb of Father Baker and I pray through him and Our Lady of Victory for all of our parishioners, donors and benefactors and all of our employees, that God will bless you all and help us continue to serve all God's people, especially the poor and most vulnerable in our midst.

UPDATE ON CONTINUING RESTORATION PROJECTS:

<u>Dome Roofing</u>: Base of dome gutter and sill flashing removal and replacements have commenced and will be completed in two to three weeks. Scaffolding is now in place on the North, South, and East elevations; West elevation scaffolding will be complete in the next two weeks. Starting on October 8, a large 360-ton crane will be brought onsite and used to install the dome roofing access ring / platform / ladder assemblies. This crane will be onsite for about two weeks (weather dependent).

Non-Dome Roofing: Southwest corner coating work will be completed in a week. Once completed, the low south elevation flat roof removals and replacements will commence and will require 2-3 weeks to complete. After that work, the final coating work at mansard elements surrounding the flat roof elements will be completed.

Basilica Window Refurbishment:
On Monday, September 30, a scaffold will be erected inside the east nave so that the upper nave stained glass windows can be removed and replaced. This work should take a month and a half to complete. Related pews will be covered for protection.

Sanctuary Plaster Repairs: On Monday, September 30, a scaffold section will be erected behind the pulpit in the sanctuary to effect the plaster removal and plumbing rainwater piping replacements, together with related plaster restoration and painting. This work could take 3-4 weeks to complete. This small scaffold should have at most a minor visual impact on the Sanctuary space.

I am most grateful to our Construction Project Team for their amazing work in shepherding these projects forward. I pray daily for the intercession of Father Baker to bless the work that is being done to restore our magnificent Basilica as well as for the protection of Our Lady of Victory for all of our construction workers.

I am also profoundly grateful to all our donors, benefactors, parishioners and friends for their generous support of our Centennial Campaign and our *Save* the *Dome/Adopt an Angel* Community Campaign. God bless you all!




