DEAR BROTHERS AND SISTERS IN CHRIST,



Friday School Masses will be moved to the School Gym, beginning on Friday, April 25 at 8:15 a.m. There will only be two Fridays when the School Masses will take place in the Basilica: May 30 for Ribbon Day and June 6 for the 8th Grade Baccalaureate Mass.
