### A MESSAGE FROM OUR PASTOR

## DEAR SISTERS AND BROTHERS IN CHRIST,

At the time of the writing of this bulletin column, our Holy Father, Pope Francis, remains hospitalized. I encourage everyone to join me in continuing to pray for him at this time:

O God, shepherd and ruler of all the faithful, look favorably on your servant Francis, whom you have set at the head of your Church as her shepherd. Grant, we pray, that by word and example he may be of service to those over whom he presides so that, together with the flock entrusted to his care, he may come to everlasting life. Through our Lord Jesus Christ, your Son, who lives and reigns with you in the unity of the Holy Spirit, one God, for ever and ever. Amen.

#### THE SEASON OF LENT

Lent is ordered to preparing for the celebration of Easter, since the Lenten liturgy prepares for celebration of the Paschal Mystery both catechumens (unbaptized), by the various stages of Christian Initiation, and the faithful, who recall their own Baptism and do penance. The 40 days of Lent run from Ash Wednesday up to but excluding the Mass of the Lord's Supper. From the beginning of Lent until the Easter Vigil, the *Alleluia* is not said.

Abstinence: All Catholics who have reached their 14th birthday are bound to abstain totally from meat on the following days: Ash Wednesday, all Fridays of Lent and Good Friday.

Fasting: All Catholics between their 18th and 59th birthdays are also bound to observe the Law of Fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. This practice involves limiting oneself to a single full meal and avoiding food between meals. Light sustenance may be taken on two other occasions in the course of the day.

Stations of the Cross & Friday Evening Masses during Lent: Every Friday during Lent we will have Stations of the Cross at 7:00 p.m. followed by Mass at 7:30 p.m.

### "THAT YOU MIGHT HAVE LIFE" A LENTEN PARISH MISSION FOR EUCHARISTIC REVIVAL

March 24, 25, and 26

I encourage you to please plan on participating in our three-day Lenten Parish Mission here in the Basilica later this month. Fr. Charles Marie Rooney, O.P. and Fr. Luke Mary VanBerkum, O.P., members of the Order of Preachers (the Dominicans), will lead us on this parish mission to help us better understand how the Eucharist transforms us, renews us, and fills us with hope.

Fr. Charles was raised in Darien, CT, graduated with a B.A. from Duke University in 2016 and an M.A. in philosophy



from Maynooth University, Ireland in 2017, and was ordained a priest in 2024. He is presently assigned in Washington, DC, where he is finishing his licentiate in sacred theology and providing local pastoral assistance in English and Spanish.

Fr. Luke grew up outside of Detroit, MI, graduated from the University of Notre Dame in 2016, and was ordained a priest in 2022



in Washington, DC. He spent a year finishing a licentiate in sacred theology, and now serves as parochial vicar at St. Gertrude Church in Cincinnati, OH.

The three-day mission will begin with talks on Monday, March 24 and Tuesday, March 25, and then will culminate with a solemn Eucharistic Healing Service on Wednesday, March 26. Each day's event will be offered following the 12:10 p.m. daily

Mass and then again at 6:30 p.m. in the evening. Please feel free to attend whichever time works best for you. The mission will also include plentiful opportunities for Confession, Eucharistic Adoration, and praying the Rosary. I know that their message will be exactly what we all need to hear, especially during these challenging times for our Church. Please come and bring a friend and spread the word... All are welcome!
