

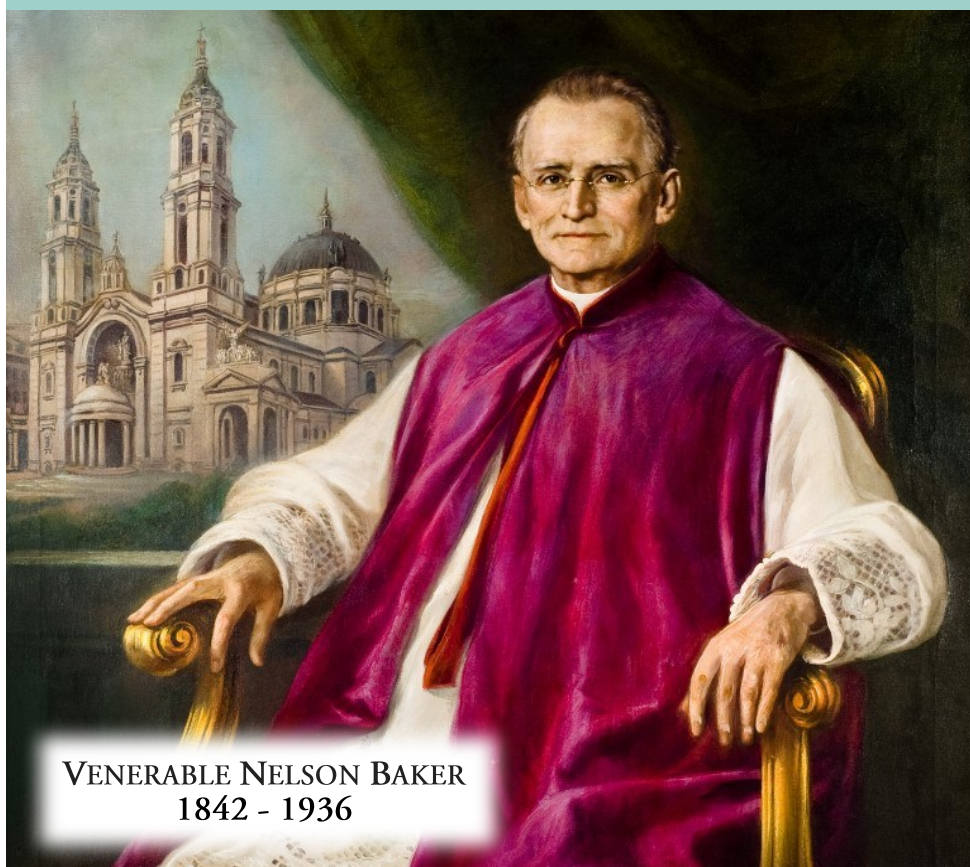

A MESSAGE FROM OUR PASTOR

DEAR BROTHERS AND SISTERS IN CHRIST,

WELCOME ALL TO FATHER BAKER WEEKEND:

This weekend, we gather to recall the anniversary of the death of our beloved founder, Venerable Nelson Baker, who passed away on July 29, 1936 at the age of 94 after 60 years of selfless and dedicated priestly ministry to thousands of children, youth and families.

When it was clear to all that Father Baker's death was imminent, some twenty Sisters of St. Joseph and Brothers of the Holy Infancy and Youth of Jesus gathered outside his room at Our Lady of Victory Hospital to recite the Litany of the Dying and the Rosary. Surrounded by Monsignor John Nash, Administrator of the Diocese at the time, Father Joseph Burke, and Dr. Michael Sullivan, Father Baker died on July 29, 1936 at 9:20 a.m. The cause of death was listed as cardiac exhaustion and dilation.

Father Baker left the world the way he entered it, a poor man who sought only God's glory. His will, written on July 7, 1922, with three other accompanying codicils, demonstrated his poverty. He wrote: *I have no money in the bank, no bonds or securities of any kind or form. I am indebted to no one financially, and no one is indebted to me... There is no salary due me... I have no property of any kind, except certain chattels donated to me by kind friends during my life, such as books, altar furniture, certain articles of furniture, clothing, etc. and I wish the Institutions which have been under my charge in Lackawanna to have these.*

In the codicils, Father Baker spoke of the joy of the priesthood, his absolute faith in the intercession of Our Lady of Victory, and his desire for the Institutions to continue through the good work of the Sisters of St. Joseph.

Thankfully, to this very day, the legacy of Fr. Baker that was handed on to the Sisters of St. Joseph, and then to other

strong lay leaders and dedicated priests and religious, continues as we serve over 12,000 children, youth, families and individuals each year through OLV Human Services, OLV Charities, and OLV National Shrine & Basilica and OLV Elementary School.

As we honor Father Baker this weekend, let us follow his example and place our unfailing faith and trust in God through the protection of Our Lady of Victory. And by Father Baker's ardent concern for those in need, may our hearts and lives be inflamed with compassion for the poor, justice for the oppressed, hope for the troubled, and courage to those in doubt. Amen!

OUR WEEKEND EVENTS:

On **Saturday, August 1**, our first annual Car Show begins at 3:00 p.m. in the parking lot. At the same time, our split club, basket raffles, silent auction, and food and beverages begin in the main tents, along with an expanded Kids' Zone. Inside the Basilica, we welcome the Contemporary Jazz Ensemble to lead us in a Pre-Mass Jazz Concert at 4:00 p.m. on Saturday, followed by a special Jazz Mass at 4:30 p.m. After Mass, the fun continues outside in the tents, with live music by Tim Britt, a Buffalo singer-songwriter with an engaging, request-driven solo acoustic performance.

On **Sunday, August 2**, we have our traditional "Pennies to Heaven" coin drop-off beginning at 7:30 a.m. in front of the Basilica, followed by the 12:00 Noon Father Baker Day Mass with the presentation of the floral wreath at the tomb of Father Baker. After Mass, we have our family-friendly carnival and Chiavetta's Chicken BBQ in the parking lot from 1:00—5:00 p.m. Purchase a chicken dinner to enjoy with your family and friends! Entertainment will include live music, basket raffles, 50/50 split drawings, a wine toss game, a dunk tank, and expanded activities and games for children in our special Kid's Zone.

Artwork from our annual "Paint Out," when regional artists come to capture

the beauty of our incredible Shrine, is on display in the museum throughout this weekend. Many paintings are for sale; artists' contact info is available to arrange for purchase. For more information, contact Eileen Hudson at OLV Charities at 716-828-7585.

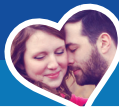
