A MESSAGE FROM OUR PASTOR

DEAR BROTHERS AND SISTERS IN CHRIST,

OLV ELEMENTARY SCHOOL

This transition is a positive step forward that strengthens Catholic education in Western New York and unites families around the shared values of faith, service, and academic excellence.

Rooted in the enduring legacy of Father Nelson Baker, OLV Elementary has served families for 130 years. Father Baker believed deeply in the transformative power of Catholic education, and that belief continues to guide the mission of OLV Elementary today. As students and families come together under one roof, this consolidation honors that legacy while building a strong and vibrant future for Catholic education in our community.

OLV Elementary remains fully committed to the families and students who already call the school home, while also extending a warm and prayerful welcome to those joining from Catholic Academy of West Buffalo. School leadership is dedicated to ensuring this transition is thoughtful, supportive, and grounded in the values that unite us as a Catholic community.

I ask our parish community to keep all students, families, faculty and staff in your prayers during this time of transition. Together, guided by faith and inspired by Father Baker's vision, we move forward as one OLV community!

THE SEASON OF LENT

Lent is ordered to preparing for the celebration of Easter, since the Lenten

liturgy prepares for celebration of the Paschal Mystery both catechumens (unbaptized), by the various stages of Christian Initiation, and the faithful, who recall their own Baptism and do penance. The forty days of Lent run from Ash Wednesday up to but excluding the Mass of the Lord's Supper exclusive. From the beginning of Lent until the Easter Vigil, the *Alleluia* is not said.

Abstinence: All Catholics who have reached their 14th birthday are bound to abstain totally from meat on the following days: Ash Wednesday, all Fridays of Lent and Good Friday.

Fasting: All Catholics between their 18th and 59th birthdays are also bound to observe the Law of Fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. This practice involves limiting oneself to a single full meal and avoiding food between meals. Light sustenance may be taken on two other occasions in the course of the day.

LENTEN CATHOLIC CHARITIES APPEAL 2026:

The Season of Lent always coincides with our Annual Catholic Charities Appeal and Fund for the Faith. As we heard on Ash Wednesday, the three disciplines of Lent are Prayer, Fasting and Almsgiving. There is no better way to exercise the call to almsgiving than to support our Catholic Charities Appeal, which last year helped provide many essential services to those who needed it most in our community.

The funds from the Appeal support dozens of Catholic Charities programs and services, and every dollar raised results in \$5-\$6 in additional funding

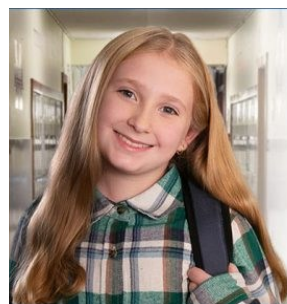

from grants and government contracts. Appeal dollars directly support programs like food pantries, emergency financial assistance, extensive behavioral health programs, and much more. 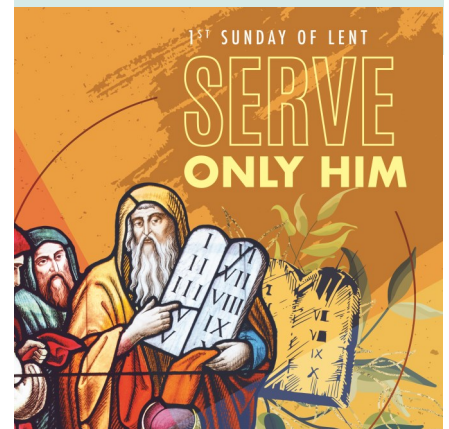

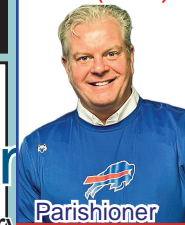
