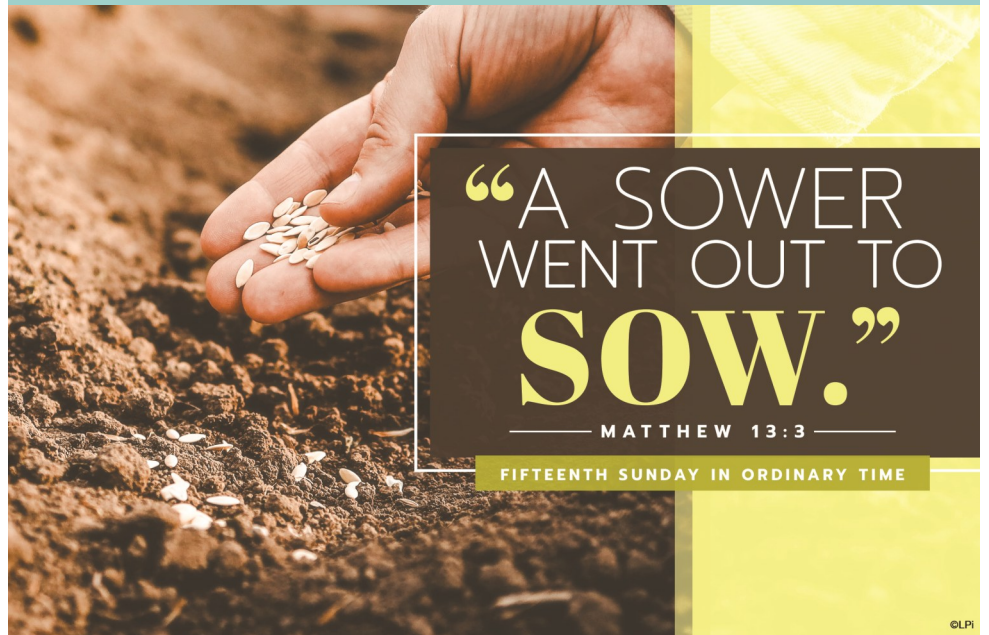

DEAR BROTHERS AND SISTERS IN CHRIST,

OFFERTORY ENVELOPE UPDATE

As you know, our offertory envelope provider, Cathedral Letter Concepts (formerly Cathedral Corporation), has experienced production and mailing delays throughout this year.

In an effort to reset its schedule and be on time moving forward, Cathedral will not be sending the remaining July envelopes, in order to catch up production for its customers. Instead, they are moving forward with August envelopes to ensure that those are delivered on time and that they are on schedule moving forward. Their latest communication states that, "We are committed to restoring the reliable service you expect and deserve."

If you find yourself without a current envelope, please use any previous envelope (if you still have one available) and write the correct date on it, or use any blank envelope and add your name with ID number, if known. You may also choose to give online by going to olvbasilica.org and clicking the *Give* button. Thank you for your patience and continued contributions despite the difficulties in receiving timely envelopes.

MISSION COOPERATIVE APPEAL

Our Mission Cooperative envelope contributions this year go directly to support the **Society of St. Peter the Apostle (SPA)**, which was established to support the formation of local clergy in mission territories. From the 16th to the 19th century, the Holy See repeatedly emphasized the importance of developing an indigenous clergy. While missionaries understood that



their work would be incomplete without forming local priests, they often struggled with significant challenges—most notably, a lack of resources to establish seminaries and train seminarians. On the weekend of June 21st, we welcomed Fr. Augustine Dada, National Director of the Society of St. Peter the Apostle, who preached at each Mass.
