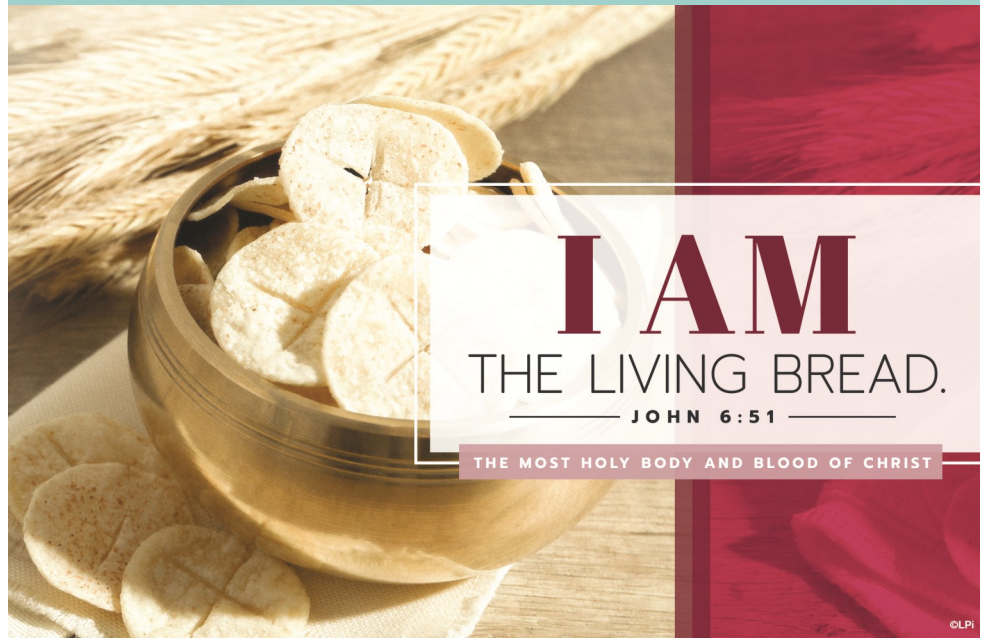

A MESSAGE FROM OUR PASTOR

DEAR BROTHERS AND SISTERS IN CHRIST,

SOLEMNITY OF THE MOST HOLY BODY AND BLOOD OF CHRIST:

Sunday, June 7—Noon Mass with Eucharistic Procession

The Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ is also known as the Solemnity of Corpus Christi, which translates from Latin to "Body of Christ." This feast originated in France in the mid-thirteenth century and was extended to the whole Church by Pope Urban IV in 1264. This feast is celebrated on the Thursday following Trinity Sunday or, as in the USA, on the Sunday following that feast.

This feast calls us to focus on two manifestations of the Body of Christ, the Holy Eucharist and the Church. The primary purpose of this feast is to focus our attention on the Eucharist. The opening prayer at Mass calls our attention to Jesus' suffering and death and our worship of Him, especially in the Eucharist. At every Mass, our attention is called to the Eucharist and the Real Presence of Christ in it. The secondary focus of this feast is upon the Body of Christ as it is present in the Church. The Church is called the Body of Christ because of the intimate communion which Jesus shares with his disciples. He expresses this in the gospels by using the metaphor of a body in which He is the head. This image helps keep in focus both the unity and the diversity of the Church.

The Feast of Corpus Christi is commonly used as an opportunity for public Eucharistic processions, which serves as a sign of common faith and adoration. Our worship of Jesus in His Body and Blood calls us to offer to God our Father a pledge of undivided love and an offering of ourselves to the service of others. At the conclusion of this Sunday's Noon Mass, we will have a Procession with the Blessed Sacrament through the Basilica and then outdoors, and we will end with Benediction back in the Basilica. All are welcome to participate.

DELAY IN ENVELOPE MAILING

Cathedral Corporation, our offertory envelope provider, has continued to experience mailing delays, but the company's Chairman and CEO, Marianne Gage, has released a statement indicating that the issues should soon be resolved. She writes:

"Please accept our sincere apology for the continuing envelope production issues we have experienced since the beginning of 2026. . . . Some of the delays arose after one of our major vendors declared bankruptcy late last year, affecting our supply of envelopes. Since then, we have secured additional supplier partnerships to help ensure more consistent and timely production. In addition, we have invested . . . in a new production line to improve efficiency and quality. Work to repair equipment failures was delayed when parts being shipped from overseas were held up for weeks in customs, but we now have installed equipment, updated programming and are using cameras to assist in ensuring quality. . . . We believe the changes we have made will allow us to return to timely delivery of our envelopes to all customers shortly, and definitely by midyear."

Until you receive your envelopes, if you wish to make a weekly contribution, you may use any plain envelope and write your name and ID number on it. You are also welcome to drop a loose check in the collection (with your ID number on it, if possible) or to utilize online giving (visit olvbasilica.org and click *Give*). Thank you for your patience and continued generosity!

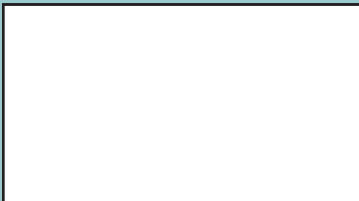

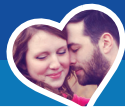
