A MESSAGE FROM OUR PASTOR

DEAR BROTHERS AND SISTERS IN CHRIST,

HAPPY 100th ANNIVERSARY OF THE CONSECRATION OF OUR LADY OF VICTORY NATIONAL SHRINE & BASILICA!

What a glorious celebration this is! My heart is truly overflowing with gratitude and immense joy for each of you who made the restoration of Father Baker's "crown jewel" possible.

We gather to celebrate the 100th Anniversary of the Consecration of Our Lady of Victory National Shrine & Basilica. One hundred years ago, His Eminence Patrick Cardinal Hayes, the Archbishop of New York, came to Buffalo and gave the sermon for the Solemn Consecration Mass here on May 25, 1926.

In his sermon that day, Cardinal Hayes stated: *"I know of no church like this, so beautiful, so uplifting, so glorious—I know of no other church like this, consecrated to the Charities of Christ, Our Lord. It is a monument to the Buffalo Diocese, the City of Lackawanna, to our great Lady of Victory and to a modern Apostle of Charity—Father Baker."*

I echo those same sentiments one hundred years later in our beautifully restored Basilica and I want to sincerely thank everyone who played a part in making all of this happen!

I extend sentiments of deepest gratitude and appreciation to David Kersten and our entire OLV Charities Team for their exemplary leadership during the entire Centennial Celebration 2021-2026, as well as to Cindy Lee and our OLV Human Services Leadership Team for daily carrying forward Father Baker's legacy of dedicated service to the children, youth, and families entrusted to our care. I also wish to acknowledge the members of our construction team and all the craftsmen for their artistic creativity in restoring the Basilica to the breathtaking magnificence it had



when Father Baker built it one hundred years ago.

The Basilica was the crowning jewel to Father Baker's "City of Charity" and the fruition of his longtime desire to build a magnificent church to the Mother of God, as a way to give thanks to Our Lady of Victory for her constant patronage throughout his priestly ministry. As is well known, whenever anyone gave accolades to Father Baker for all of the services he provided for children and families in need, he humbly replied, "She did it all," as he pointed toward the beautiful statue of Our Lady of Victory. And indeed, as we honor our Blessed Mother as our patroness, we know that truly "She did it all!"

I am pleased this weekend to welcome the Fifteenth Bishop of Buffalo, Bishop Michael Fisher, as he comes to celebrate with us as we conclude our five-year Centennial Celebration here at Our Lady of Victory. We also welcome all of our dedicated parishioners and our generous donors and benefactors.

Our Centennial theme has been "All Are Welcome" and we sincerely hope that everyone feels welcome here at

OLV! The renewed beauty gives honor to Our Lady of Victory, while ensuring that the legacy of The Venerable Nelson Baker, Our Lady of Victory National Shrine & Basilica, will continue to be a beacon of hope and inspiration for generations to come.

SOLEMNITY OF THE MOST HOLY TRINITY:

This week, we return to the liturgical season of Ordinary Time. This Sunday and next, however, are designated as solemnities—special days that call our attention to central mysteries of our faith. Today on Trinity Sunday, we celebrate the mystery of the Holy Trinity, one God in three persons.

Today's Gospel is from the beginning of John's Gospel. The passage we read follows Jesus' conversation with a Pharisee, Nicodemus, about what it means to be born of both water and the spirit. Nicodemus approaches Jesus at night and acknowledges Jesus as a teacher from God. Jesus tells him that only those who are born from above will see the Kingdom of God.

Nicodemus misunderstands and questions how a person can be born

more than once. Jesus tells Nicodemus that no one can enter the Kingdom of God without being born of water and Spirit. Jesus is essentially explaining Baptism, which we celebrate as a sacrament today. Yet Nicodemus, we are told, still does not understand what Jesus is saying. Jesus continues by testifying to the need to be born from above so that one might have eternal life.

After the dialogue with Nicodemus, the author of the Gospel offers his own explanation of Jesus' words. This is what we read in today's Gospel, John 3:16-18.

In the context of today's focus on the mystery of the Holy Trinity, the reading calls our attention to the action of God, who reveals himself in three persons: God the Father, Jesus the Son, and the Holy Spirit. God the Father, out of love for the world, sent his Son into the world in order to save it. Through the death and resurrection of the Son, we have been given the gift of the Holy Spirit. As three persons, God acts always as a God of love; he does not condemn the world but acts to save it.



The Gospel also calls attention to the response that is required of us. God's love for us calls us to respond in faith by professing our belief in God's son, Jesus, and the salvation that he has won for us. This profession of faith is a sign of the work of the Holy Spirit in our lives.

SOLEMNITY OF THE MOST HOLY BODY AND BLOOD OF CHRIST:

Sunday, June 7 at Noon Mass

Next Sunday, we will have a special celebration in honor of the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ (traditionally referred to as the Feast of Corpus Christi). At the

conclusion of Mass, we will have a procession with the Blessed Sacrament outside and then conclude with Benediction in the Basilica. In case of rain, the procession will take place inside the Basilica. All are welcome to attend.

CATHOLIC CHARITIES APPEAL:

As you know, our Parish Goal here at Our Lady of Victory National Shrine & Basilica for this year's appeal is \$172,709. **To date, we have raised \$145,152 from 238 donors, which is 84% of our parish goal.** I thank all those who have contributed thus far.

DIOCESAN BANKRUPTCY UPDATE

Dear Parish Family:

As you know, the Diocese of Buffalo bankruptcy proceedings have been pending for more than six years. In furtherance of the efforts of all Parishes within the Diocese to achieve a fair and just resolution of abuse claims, and in an effort to bring the bankruptcy proceedings of the Diocese of Buffalo to a successful conclusion, a revised Chapter 11 plan that soon will be filed by the Diocese provides that all parishes in the Diocese of Buffalo will file "rapid prepackaged bankruptcy" cases immediately before a hearing on confirmation of the plan. This will happen if and only if sufficient votes are received for approval of the plan. This approach has the support of pastors and the Diocese.

The parish bankruptcy cases will not be commenced until later this year and will come at the very

last minute before the "confirmation" hearing on approval of the Diocese's plan. It is anticipated that parishes will emerge from bankruptcy within 48 hours. This approach has been discussed among all pastors and is the approach that was followed by parishes in the Diocese of Rockville Centre as well as in the Archdiocese of New Orleans which resulted in the successful resolution and emergence from their respective Chapter 11 cases.

We will provide further updates as this process advances and are heartened at the possibility of at last providing victim-survivors the possibility of closure and healing. With the prospect of finally achieving this goal, we look to the future with renewed commitment and focus on our mission and work in service to the Catholic faithful throughout Western New York and our broader community.

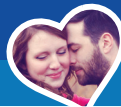
