Thank you for your patience and understanding during this time of ongoing restoration to care for our magnificent Basilica!



**DIVINE MERCY SUNDAY:
JESUS, I TRUST IN YOU!**

In the Gospel of St. John for the Second Sunday of Easter, we read of one of the first post-resurrection appearances of the Risen Lord Jesus to His disciples. "On the evening of the first day of the week, when the doors were locked, where the disciples were, for fear of the Jews, Jesus came and stood in their midst and said to them, 'Peace be with you.' When he had said this, he showed them his hands and his side. The disciples rejoiced when they saw the Lord. Jesus said to them again, 'Peace be with you.'" My prayer for all of you is that when you reflect on this gospel today, you will hear the voice of Jesus speak to your heart, "Peace be with you!" With all of the uncertainty and the challenges we continue to face, we need to rely on the Lord Jesus and place our faith in His Risen Presence in our midst and know and believe

that He will never leave us and will see us through whatever difficulties and challenges we face in our daily lives. May our prayer simply be "Jesus, I trust In You!"

I hope you will join me this Sunday for our Eucharistic Holy Hour at 3:00 p.m. for Divine Mercy Sunday. It will include Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament, a Liturgy of the Word, Reflection, Recitation of the Chaplet of Divine Mercy, Veneration of the Image of Divine Mercy, and Intercessions, and will conclude with Benediction and the Divine Praises. All are welcome!

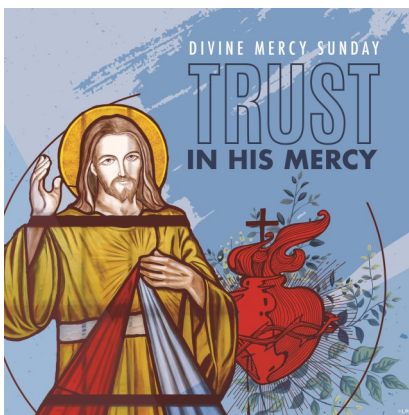

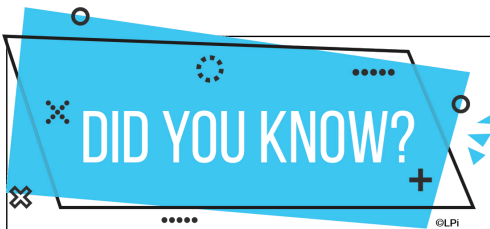


FOLLOW IN THE FOOTSTEPS OF SAINT PAUL
