ASCENSION THURSDAY: Holy Day of Obligation

(see Mass schedule for May 13 & 14)

This week on Thursday, we celebrate the Ascension of the Lord, a Holy Day of Obligation. The Ascension, which occurred 40 days after Jesus Christ rose from the dead on Easter, is the final act of our redemption that Christ began on Good Friday. On this day, the risen Christ, in the sight of the Apostles, ascended bodily into heaven. Christ's bodily Ascension foreshadows our own entrance into heaven, not simply as souls after our death, but as glorified bodies after the resurrection of the dead at the Final Judgment. The Feast of the Ascension marks the beginning of the first novena, nine days of prayer. Before His Ascension, Christ promised to send the Holy Spirit to His Apostles. Their prayer for the coming of the Holy Spirit, which began at the Ascension, ended with the descent of the Holy Spirit on Pentecost Sunday, ten days later. "Come Holy Spirit, fill the hearts of your faithful and kindle in them the fire of your love."

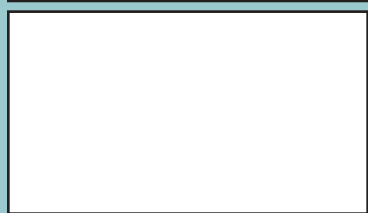

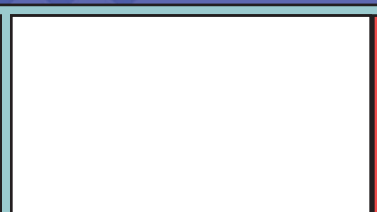


