**Sacrament of Baptism:**

Our Parish offers a special Pre-Baptism preparation program for parents who desire to share their faith with their children. Parents-to-be must attend this class prior to the birth of their child. Baptisms are usually scheduled two times each month. Call the Rectory to register for classes. Godparents must be Confirmed and practicing Catholics. Non-parishioners are required to have a Letter of Recommendation to serve as a sponsor.

**Sacrament of Marriage:**

To be married in the Basilica, you must be an active parishioner for at least 9 months prior to setting a date. Engaged couples should contact the pastor before making other wedding arrangements. Couples are required to attend a Pre-Cana Conference, or equivalent pre-marriage preparation program.

**Letters of Recommendation:**

Recommendations to act as sponsors for Baptism or Confirmation can be issued only to registered members of Our Lady of Victory Parish who have received the Sacrament of Confirmation, attend Mass and receive Holy Communion regularly, have their children attending a Catholic school or Religious Education class. If married, the marriage must be in conformity with the regulations of the Catholic Church.

**Devotions:**

Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament begins immediately after the 12:10 p.m. Mass in the Basilica on Fridays and concludes with Benediction at 5:00 p.m.

**First Friday:**

On the eve of the First Friday of each month there are confessions from 3:00 to 4:00 p.m. Mass is celebrated at 7:30 p.m. on First Friday.

**Care of the Sick:**

Please notify the rectory office for a visit to any family member who is sick, in the hospital or confined to home. Regular home Communion visits are usually on the First Friday of the month by a priest, deacon, or minister of the Eucharist.

**A Message from the Pastor**

To say that these are extremely challenging times for the Catholic Church here in our diocese and throughout New York State, as well as our entire country and our world, is indeed an understatement. I know that we are all deeply troubled and saddened by the continuous deluge of sexual abuse cases within the Church as well as in society over many years.

First and foremost I want to assure you of my prayers and loving support as your pastor. I also invite everyone to continue to pray for the true victims of abuse for their healing and for justice. On August 14, 2019, the Child Victims Act (CVA) to bring claims of sexual abuse against our Diocese and the other Dioceses and institutions in New York State opened. I pray that this will be an opportunity for the true victims of sexual abuse to get the justice they so deeply deserve as well as to bring about a measure of healing that will allow them to move forward in a positive direction in their lives.

It can all be very overwhelming and you may be tempted to walk away from the Church or you may know people who have already left. I encourage you from the bottom of my heart not to give up but to stay the course. The reason we go to Mass is not for the priest, the bishop or even the Pope; we go to Mass because of Jesus Christ and our need to center and root our lives in God's love and mercy. The Eucharist, the Real Presence of Jesus Christ, is our spiritual food that strengthens us to live our lives in faithfulness and trust. We also need to come together as a community of faith to support and strengthen one another. Witnessing to our faith, especially in challenging times, serves to edify one another and bring us closer together. When a family undergoes any difficulties that life may present, it is those families that come together that are sustained as well as continue to thrive. We are a "family" here at Our Lady of Victory Basilica and we need to help each other as we all strive to do our best to remain faithful to God and to support and strengthen the Church Our Lord has entrusted to us. I know that some people feel that in order to correct mistakes made in the past by our diocese, it is necessary to withdraw membership or withhold contributions, in order to bring about necessary change. The reality is, by doing this, you will not necessarily hurt the Bishop, but it will hurt the very people we need to serve, which is you, all of our beloved parishioners and all who come here to Our Lady of Victory National Shrine and Basilica. In the midst of all the negative publicity the Church is receiving in the press and social media... we must remember all the good the Church does for the people of God and for all people regardless of their faith tradition.

Here at Our Lady of Victory we are striving to carry on the great legacy of our beloved founder, Father Baker. Through your support of Our Lady of Victory Basilica, the OLV Homes of Charity and Baker Victory Services, you are helping us care for over 4,200 children, youth, adults and families every year. We are providing a quality Catholic education to over 180 children through Our Lady of Victory Elementary School as well as all the children in our Religious Education Program. It is here where you come to have your children baptized and confirmed and receive their First Eucharist. It is here where adults become members of our Catholic Faith through the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults. It is here where you come to receive the Sacraments of Penance, Anointing of the Sick and Marriage.

**Summary of the Readings**  
**Twenty-first Sunday in Ordinary Time**

We have become accustomed to seeing pictures in the media and stories on the news about immigrants from Latin America and refugees from Syria fleeing violence and destruction in their own countries, trying to make their way to a safe place. We have also seen the reactions of people who want to keep them away from their countries, who fail to welcome the stranger and the helpless children. Have we forgotten Jesus' call to comfort the homeless and the stranger? "They shall bring all your brothers and sisters from all the nations . . . to Jerusalem, my holy mountain, says the LORD."

In the three readings for this day, we are told that we are to welcome these strangers, to welcome the discipline of the Lord, which leads to peace, and to "strive to enter through the narrow gate" into the glory of God's own homeland, the reign of God.

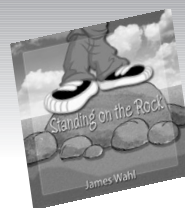
