**Sacrament of Baptism:**

Our Parish offers a special Pre-Baptism preparation program for parents who desire to share their faith with their children. Parents-to-be must attend this class prior to the birth of their child. Baptisms are usually scheduled two times each month. Call the Rectory to register for classes. Godparents must be Confirmed and practicing Catholics. Non-parishioners are required to have a Letter of Recommendation to serve as a sponsor.

**Sacrament of Marriage:**

To be married in the Basilica, you must be an active parishioner for at least 9 months prior to setting a date. Engaged couples should contact the pastor before making other wedding arrangements. Couples are required to attend a Pre-Cana Conference, or equivalent pre-marriage preparation program.

**Letters of Recommendation:**

Recommendations to act as sponsors for Baptism or Confirmation can be issued only to registered members of Our Lady of Victory Parish who have received the Sacrament of Confirmation, attend Mass and receive Holy Communion regularly, have their children attending a Catholic school or Religious Education class. If married, the marriage must be in conformity with the regulations of the Catholic Church.

**Devotions:**

Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament begins immediately after the 12:10 p.m. Mass in the Basilica on Fridays and concludes with Benediction at 5:00 p.m.

**First Friday:**

On the eve of the First Friday of each month there are confessions from 3:00 to 4:00 p.m. Mass is celebrated at 7:30 p.m. on First Friday.

**Care of the Sick:**

Please notify the rectory office for a visit to any family member who is sick, in the hospital or confined to home. Regular home Communion visits are usually on the First Friday of the month by a priest, deacon, or minister of the Eucharist.

**A Message from Father Paul**

***Congratulations to Deacon Denning Achidi, who was ordained to the Order of Deacon for the Diocese of Buffalo yesterday by Bishop Malone.*** Denning served our parish during his Pastoral Year (between his second and third year of Theology). He will assist for the first time as a deacon at our Noon Mass this Sunday, May 26. Denning will return to Christ the King Seminary for his last year of theological studies and will be assigned to St. Amelia's parish, Tonawanda, for his deacon year. We wish him well in his ministry as a deacon and look forward to his ordination to priesthood next spring.

***Happy Memorial Day this Monday.*** It is the unofficial beginning of summer (although the weather doesn't seem to be cooperating). On this day we remember all who have made the ultimate sacrifice in the service of their country. It has also become a holiday on which we remember all of our beloved deceased. We ask God's blessing on all who have gone before us into God's kingdom and especially remember those who gave their lives in defense of our country.

***Next Thursday, May 30, is the Feast of the Ascension, a holy day of obligation.*** It marks the 40<sup>th</sup> day after Easter, when Jesus returned to the right hand of the Father after his Resurrection. ***The Vigil Mass will be at 7:30 p.m. on May 29<sup>th</sup>. Masses on the Holy Day itself, will be at 7:30 a.m., 9:00 a.m., 12:10 p.m. and 4:30 p.m.***

***Next Saturday, June 1, Deacon Mario will be ordained to the priesthood by Bishop Malone, at St. Joseph's Cathedral at 9:30 a.m.*** Since he arrived in this country from the Philippines, our rectory has been Mario's home-away-from-home. Congratulations to Mario on his ordination. If you are able, please join him for his First Mass next Sunday, June 2, here at the Basilica at Noon. A reception will be held following the Mass. Please join him and his family, if you can. Mario's first assignment as a priest will be to St. Mary's parish, Lancaster. We pray that God will bless his ministry there.

***Our new Parochial Vicar, Justin Steeg, will also be ordained on the same day as Mario by Bishop Malone.*** We look forward to his arrival here in mid-June.

***We are quickly coming to the time when we will be engraving new memorials in the Garden of the Sacred Heart in front of the rectory.*** For the last several years, this garden has been a place where individuals or families can memorialize loved ones or special occasions. Since it is more cost effective to do this engraving when we have a number of memorials, now is the time to submit your request for these memorials. You will find the brochures giving the specifications for these engravings in the Basilica, or you may pick one up at the rectory.

***You may know that we have a group of volunteers who count the weekend collection weekly.*** They are dedicated and generous with their time. You can help make their job a bit easier by not taping or stapling your weekly collection envelope. By not doing these things, you will make their task a bit easier and quicker. Thank you.

### Summary of the Readings Sixth Sunday of Easter

“There arose no little dissension and debate.” Did that happen at work this week? Most of us can recall run-ins with coworkers, even with the boss. Did it happen while socializing with friends? Go easy on politics, religion . . . even sports. At home? Even the most peaceful household experiences a little “give and take” now and then. So where was it that “there arose no little dissension and debate”? That tumultuous conflict occurred among our first Christian ancestors, disrupting the community life of the early church. But today’s Acts of the Apostles shows how beautifully the Holy Spirit, promised by Jesus in today’s Gospel, helped the church achieve a grace-filled resolution. What evolved was that “reconciled diversity,” often encouraged by Pope Francis and even envisioned in today’s Revelation passage; and a wondrous experience of Jesus’ promised Gospel gift: “Peace I leave with you; my peace I give to you.” Copyright © J.
