Sacrament of Baptism:

Our Parish offers a special Pre-Baptism preparation program for parents who desire to share their faith with their children. Parents-to-be must attend this class prior to the birth of their child. Baptisms are usually scheduled two times each month. Call the Rectory to register for classes. Godparents must be Confirmed and practicing Catholics. Non-parishioners are required to have a Letter of Recommendation to serve as a sponsor.

Sacrament of Marriage:

To be married in the Basilica, you must be an active parishioner for at least 9 months prior to setting a date. Engaged couples should contact the pastor before making other wedding arrangements. Couples are required to attend a Pre-Cana Conference, or equivalent pre-marriage preparation program.

Letters of Recommendation:

Recommendations to act as sponsors for Baptism or Confirmation can be issued only to registered members of Our Lady of Victory Parish who have received the Sacrament of Confirmation, attend Mass and receive Holy Communion regularly, have their children attending a Catholic school or Religious Education class. If married, the marriage must be in conformity with the regulations of the Catholic Church.

Devotions:

Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament begins immediately after the 12:10 p.m. Mass in the Basilica on Fridays and concludes with Benediction at 5:00 p.m.

First Friday:

On the eve of the First Friday of each month there are confessions from 3:00 to 4:00 p.m. Mass is celebrated at 7:30 p.m. on First Friday.

Care of the Sick:

Please notify the rectory office for a visit to any family member who is sick, in the hospital or confined to home. Regular home Communion visits are usually on the First Friday of the month by a priest, deacon, or minister of the Eucharist.

Congratulations to the young people of our parish who will be making their First Communion this weekend. Some will be receiving the Sacrament at the Saturday 4:30 p.m. Mass. The others will be receiving the Sacrament at the Noon Mass on Sunday. Once more, congratulations to these youngsters and their families, and thanks to Carm Zomeri, our DRE, and the catechists who helped prepare these students for this important step in their faith life.

On Tuesday evening, May 7, at 7:00 p.m., we will hold our annual May Crowning ceremony. This month-of-May tradition is always the Tuesday after First Communion weekend, so that the children who made their First Communion can take part in it. The ceremony will begin in the Basilica, with prayers and the crowning of the statue of Our Lady of Victory. Weather permitting, we will process across Ridge Road to the St. Joseph Garden - to the Statue next to 780 Ridge Road - for the presentation of flowers and the final prayers and blessing. If you are coming, please bring a small bouquet of flowers, to lay at the feet of the statue of our Lady. (Pray for good weather for that evening).

Next Sunday, May 12, at the Noon Mass, I will be celebrating my 50th Anniversary of Ordination—and my June 1 retirement. I would be honored if you could join me for this celebration. Among other things, it will be a celebration of all that we have been able to do together for these past 12+ years. If you can, please join my family and friends, folks from my previous assignments in other parishes and seminaries (going back to 1969), and friends of the Our Lady of Victory Institutions, as we celebrate the sacrament of priesthood and the great legacy of Father Baker present here at OLV. ***If you are planning on attending the reception after the Noon Mass that day, please call or email Dianne Bosinski, my Administrative Assistant, (828-9424 or dbosinski@ourladyofvictory.org), so that we can plan accordingly.***

We have two other parish celebrations of priesthood in the next few weeks. Denning Achidi, who served here for his Pastoral Year, will be ordained to the diaconate on Saturday, May 25, (9:30 a.m.) at St. Joseph's Cathedral. And, on Saturday, June 1, Deacon Mario Racho, will be ordained to priesthood, also at St. Joseph's Cathedral (also at 9:30 a.m.). We, as a parish, should feel very proud to have been a part of the priestly formation of these two young men.

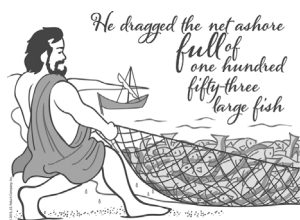

Summary of the Readings Third Sunday of Easter

"I am going fishing." What an announcement! If asked who made it, and not told it was a Bible quote, we might guess "Grandpa" or "Uncle Fred," or admit, "I said that last summer!" But it is a Bible quote, from today's Gospel. The person who said it also once declared, "You are the Christ, the Son of the living God." Yes, it's Peter! So today's announcement seems quite the comedown. Last Sunday Jesus said, "As the Father has sent me, so I send you." But Peter seems determined to return to his pre-apostolic occupation, until Jesus intervenes, making Peter's later announcement deeper, "Lord, you know that I love you," and Peter's apostolic calling clearer, "Tend my sheep." Peter does so. Acts presents the consequences: Peter declares, "We must obey God rather than men." As Revelation proclaims, "Worthy is the Lamb"—to receive Peter's lifelong service, and ours. 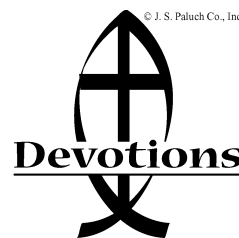
